
Summer Holiday Homework- 2024-25

*Try to converse in English with your parents in order to improve your fluency and confidence.


*Complete all the work done in books and notebooks till today in all the subjects.








1. Write the counting from 1 to 100 on a chart paper and color the even number with Red color and odd number with green color.
