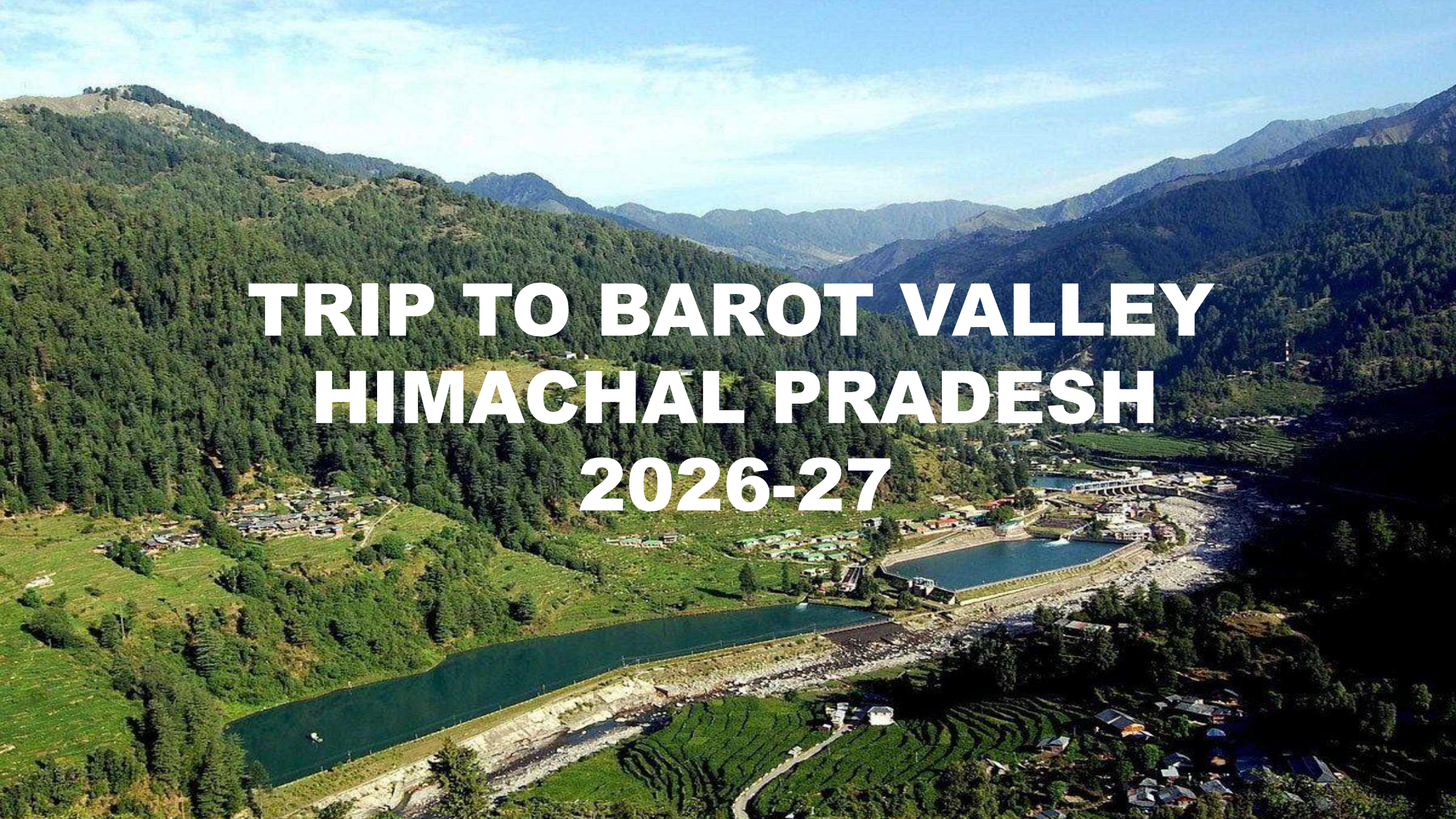
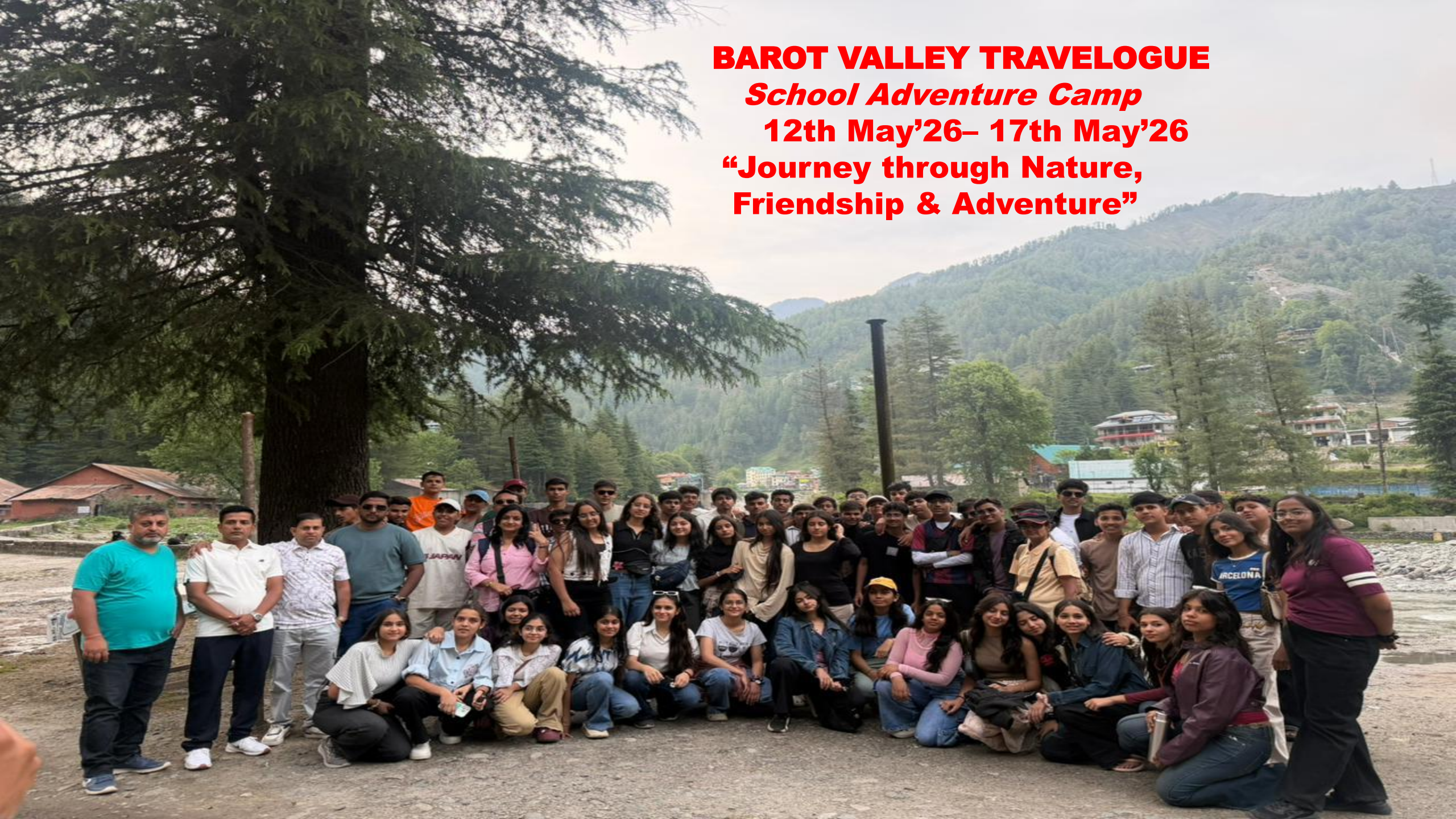

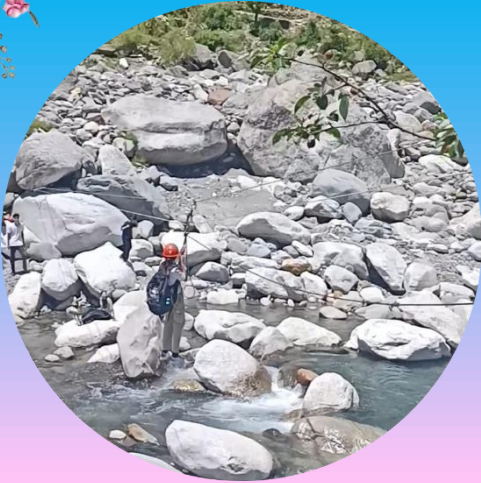
Adventure Day (14th May)

Returned to Chandigarh Railway Station

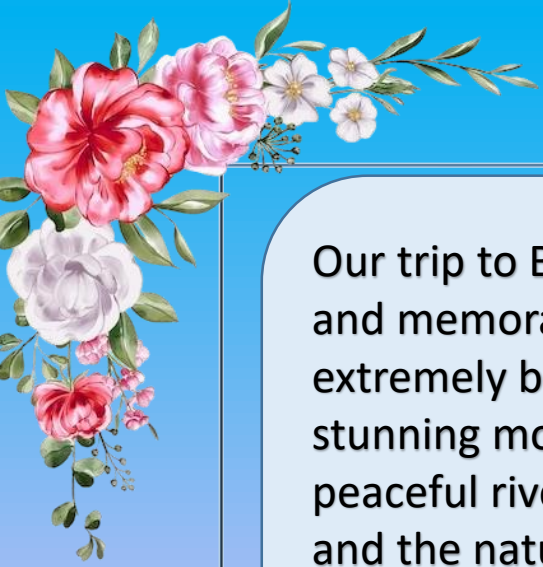
Boarded Garib Rath train for Jaipur

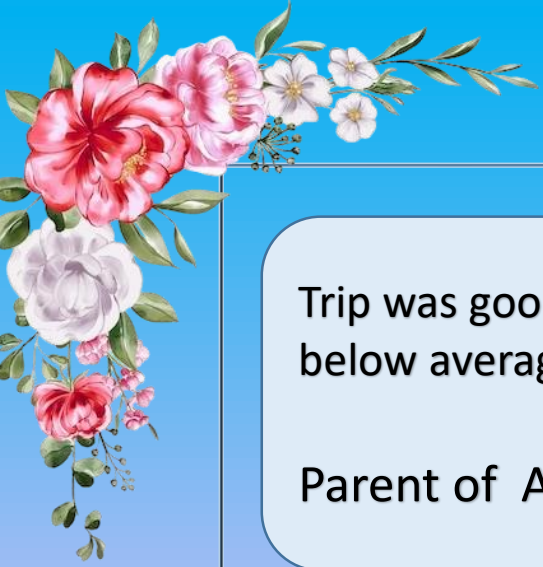
