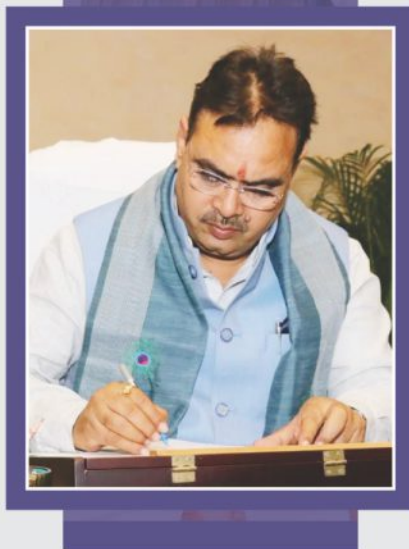

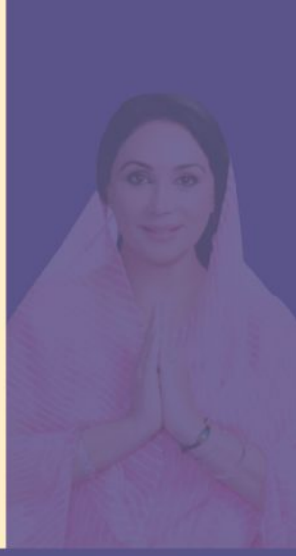
Message




From the desk of School Secretary

Message by Treasurer


*Our dreams have to be bigger, Our ambitions soaring high

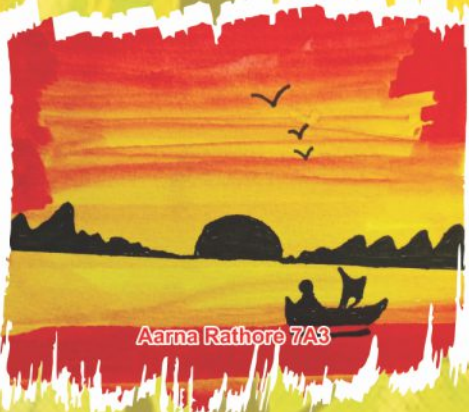


CAREER COUNSELLING SESSION AT MPS
